Summary:

The YGUSSWP conducted CPRA among 6 districts in Sana'a governorate during the period 27-31Aug 2016, to identify the needs of the conflict affected communities and IDPs specially the most vulnerable people and identify the protection risk that children exposed to in emergencies situations such as (GBV, grave violations, risks of mines & UXOs ...etc, and to contribute to the mapping efforts of the displacement locations and the size of IDPs in Sana'a governorate.

Objectives of the CP Rapid Assessment:

Conducting a CP Rapid Assessment in the conflict zones, and measure or identifying the effects of the conflict on the people in the targeted areas.

- Identifying the psychological effects of the war (conflict) on the affected and displaced (IDP) people
- Identifying the effects of the war (conflict) on children in terms of death, labor, children joined armed groups, uncombined children
- Identifying the impacts of the conflict on families and how they cope with the new situation
- Identifying the status of basic services and figure out how to access to basic services during the conflict, as well as during their displacement

Survey team:

The Yemeni General Union Sociologists, Social Workers and psychologists conduct this survey with professional team of social workers who collects the data from the targeted areas. The YGUSSWP data collection team s consists of 6 teams, and every team targeted one district, and the total numbers of the data collectors among the 6 teams were 23.

Key Findings:

In the CPRA results , we find that 90% of the interviewed household indicated that they have notice changes in their children (under 18) behavior since the beginning of the conflict or the time of movement from their homes; the study showed that (15% boys , 16% girls, 45% both boys and girls) have sleeping problems, and (13% boys , 15% girls, 23% both boys and girls) have unusual crying and screaming , and (6% boys , 10% girls, 33% both boys and girls) have sadness behaviors, and (13% boys , 3% girls, 4% both boys and girls) have disrespectable behavior , and(19% boys , 16% girls, 37% both boys and girls) having nightmares, also the study indicated that (12% boys , 6% girls, 4% both boys and girls) of the children isolating themselves from others , and (24% boys , 5% girls , 10% both boys and girls) of the children have more aggressive behavior toward others , and(19% boys , 3% girls, %9 both boys and girls) of the children are tending to practice more violence against younger children , and (8% boys , 1% girls, %7 both boys and girls) of the children are spending more time with their friends, also we find that (15% boys , 11% girls, %12 both boys and girls) of the children have bedwetting, and that there are(12% boys , 12% girls, 19% both boys and girls) of the children unwilling to go to school.

The study indicated that there are more than 23 families have one of their children or more who have been separated form them due the conflict or during their displacement, moreover 8 of the head households pointed out that some of their separated children are living with their relatives (6 boys - 7 girls), and other 7 of the heads households indicated that (10 boys -9 girls) are living with one of their friends or neighbors, and there are 6 heads households indicated that (10 boys) of their children are living elsewhere on their own. On the other hand, there are 4 of the head households have indicated that 7 of their children have been missing during displacement, in addition to that there are 3 of the head households said that their children had been detained (4 boys and 2 girls).

The study also illustrated that 13% of the targeted households have a family member had died because of the conflict or during displacement, and as result there were (18 boys- 9 girls - 20 men - 9 women) who have been died. According to the study also indicated 28% of the head household indicated that there are some of their family members have been physically affected from the conflict (15 boys - 2 girls - 4 women - 7 men) due to landmines and the remnants unexploded weapons, and there are (47 boys- 17 girls - 19 women - 22 men) have been physically affected due to airstrike booming, and other indicated that some of their family members (2 boys , 2 girls , 2 women , 5 men) have been physically affected due sexual abused .

According to the study results, there are more than 439 children (193 boys - 246 girls) in the age of school and they are out of the schools, and they need support to link them again with schools. Also there are more than 71 children with special needs, and more than 93 orphaned children. The study found that there are more than 46 pregnant women in addition to 93 lactating women within the household families that have been targeted in the study.

There are 55% of households indicated that their children need emergency assistance and to respond to their needs as a result of the conflict and displacement, where there are more than (74 boys - 35 girls) need emergency health services as a result of disability or of being physically affected by the conflict, in addition to that there are (96 boys - 92 girls) need emergency psychosocial interventions

and referral. In addition to (4 boys - 4 girls) need family reunions interventions, furthermore there are (68 boys - 68 girls) need immunization or vaccination, and there are more than 168 boys and 128 girls have malnutrition issues and they need urgent support.

There are many difficulties that children and their families are facing to reach services and these difficulties due to the lack of services for both "children and parents; the study indicated that about 210 families have difficulty to access food services, and there are more than 206 families with their children could not have sufficient water supply, also 271 families have no access to sanitation services, and there are more than 275 families have no access to health services, and 171 of the heads households indicated that their children do not have access to schools.


The study showed that most of the head household who have been interviewed have refer to some suggestions for protecting children and adults during displacement or conflict from the violation and other abuse and the most main suggestions; 57 heads of households refer to the importance of stablishing friendly safe spaces for children and 153 of the heads of households refer to the need of increasing awareness and providing psychosocial support, and other 155 of the heads households noted the importance of the provision of medical services, and 121 heads of households referred to the importance of the establishment of shelters for the displaced, and 112 heads of households noted the importance of providing food aid.
